

Organic Certification Cost Share Program

The Organic Cost-Share program, which reimburses certified organic producers and handlers for the expense of certification, is now available for 2023! You can receive 75% of your annual certification costs (up to \$500 per scope certified) paid for between 10/01/2022 – 09/30/2023. New operations must await certification prior to applying.
