Timeline - Organic handlers who operate their facility on a year-round basis may submit an Organic System Plan at any time during the year. Handlers who operate their facility on a seasonal basis must submit their Organic System Plan so that the initial inspection can occur when the facility is in operation.

Inspection fees and expenses are additional and will be billed after the inspection. Your inspector will contact you to discuss these fees before your inspection. The inspection fee is determined by the complexity of your operation, the number of sites the inspector must visit, the length of the inspection, and the travel expenses incurred by the inspector. **Inspection fees typically range from \$300 to \$1,200.**

Calculate your APPLICATION FEE

1. Base Application Fee – If you have never been certified, fees are based on projected gross sales from organic products and services for your first 12 months of certification. If currently or previously certified, fees are based on your 2025 gross sales from organic products and services. *When calculating organic gross sales from the previous year, fair market value of the organic product should be used in situations where sales occur without exchange of money (trading, bartering, etc.). Organic Gross Sales will be verified at inspection. The National Organic Certification Cost Share Program, funded by Congress, typically reimburses 75% of certification fees up to \$750 per scope (crops, livestock, handling).
